PEERS® provides evidence-based social skills intervention for adolescents, teenagers and adults interested in strengthening and developing relational skills in small group settings.

Sessions are held once a week for 90 minutes.

Adolescent and teens PEERS® have concurrent parent sessions.

Session cost:  
\$4,000/14 week

PEERS® participation is required for the full 14-week session.

Session 1: Starts the week of September 11, 2023

Session 2: Starts in January 2024

### Single Sessions or Session Packages

Session cost:  
\$150/45 min session  
OR  
\$4,600 for full 36 weeks
