

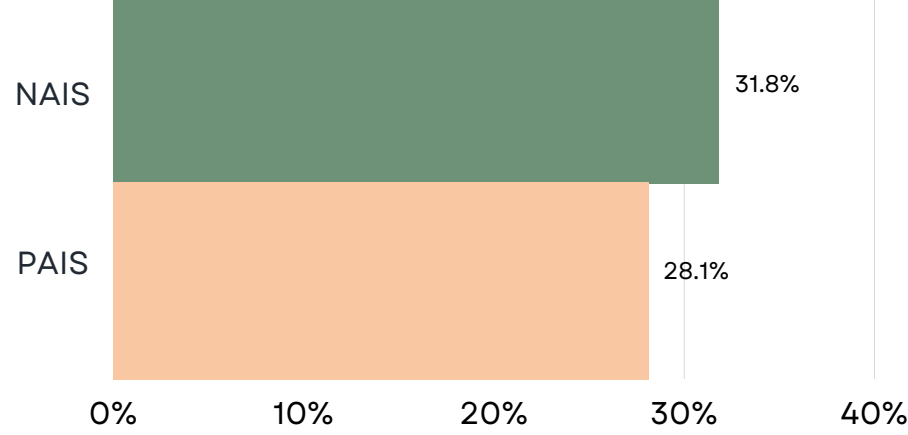

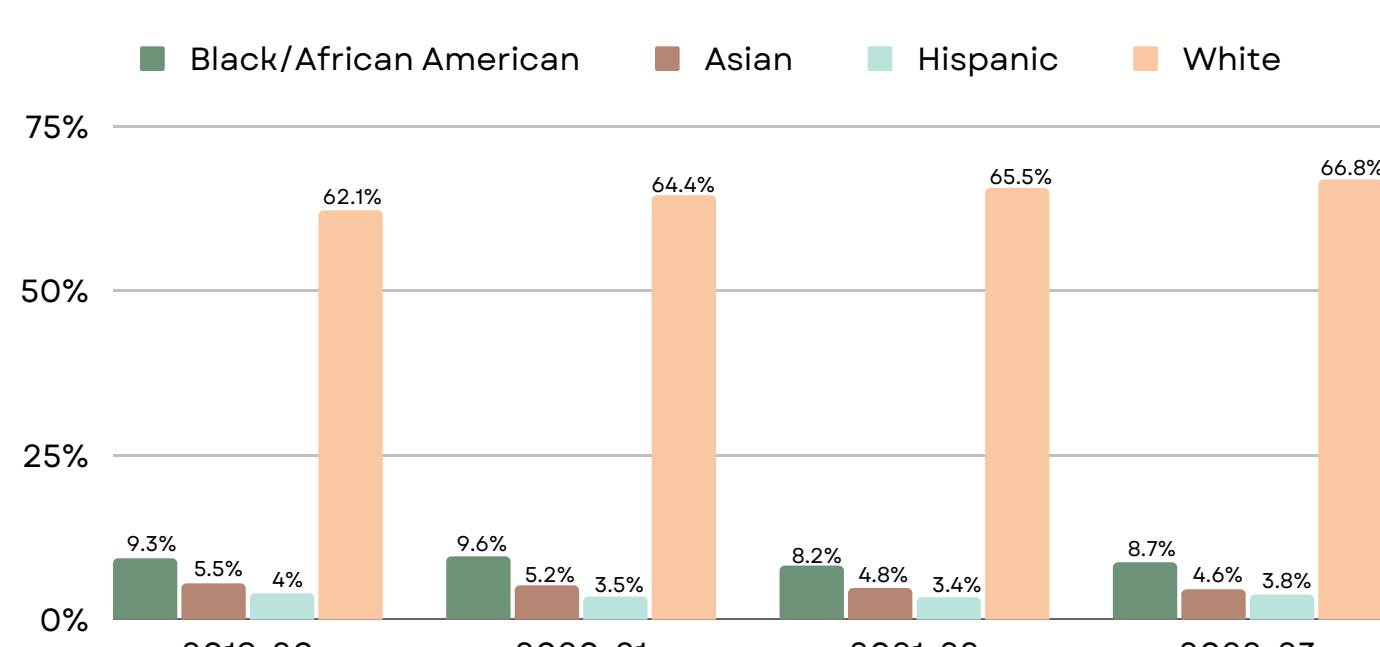

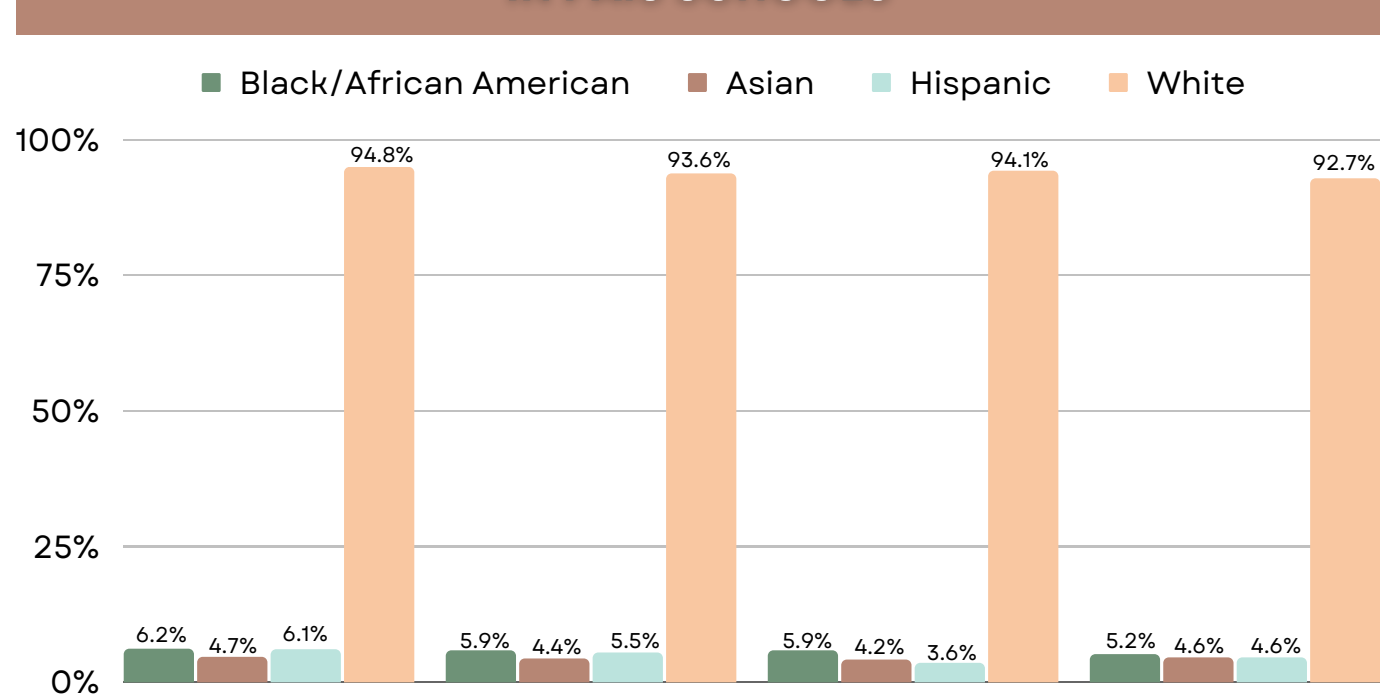
## STUDENTS OF COLOR IN NAIS SCHOOLS VS. PAIS SCHOOLS IN 2022-23



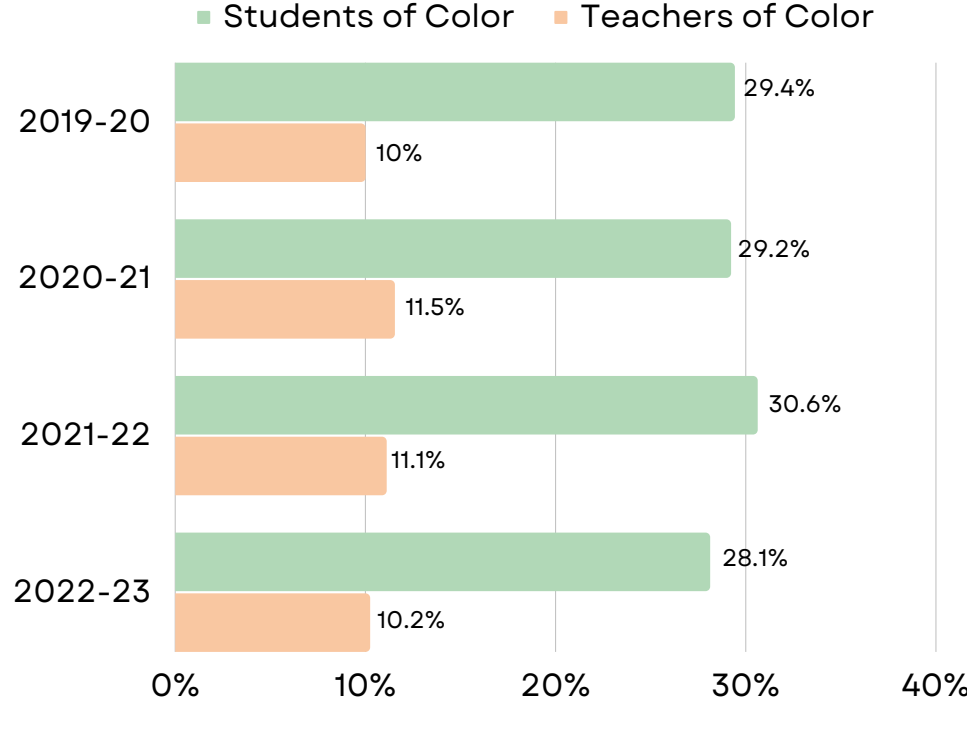
## COMPOSITION OF STUDENTS IN PAIS SCHOOLS

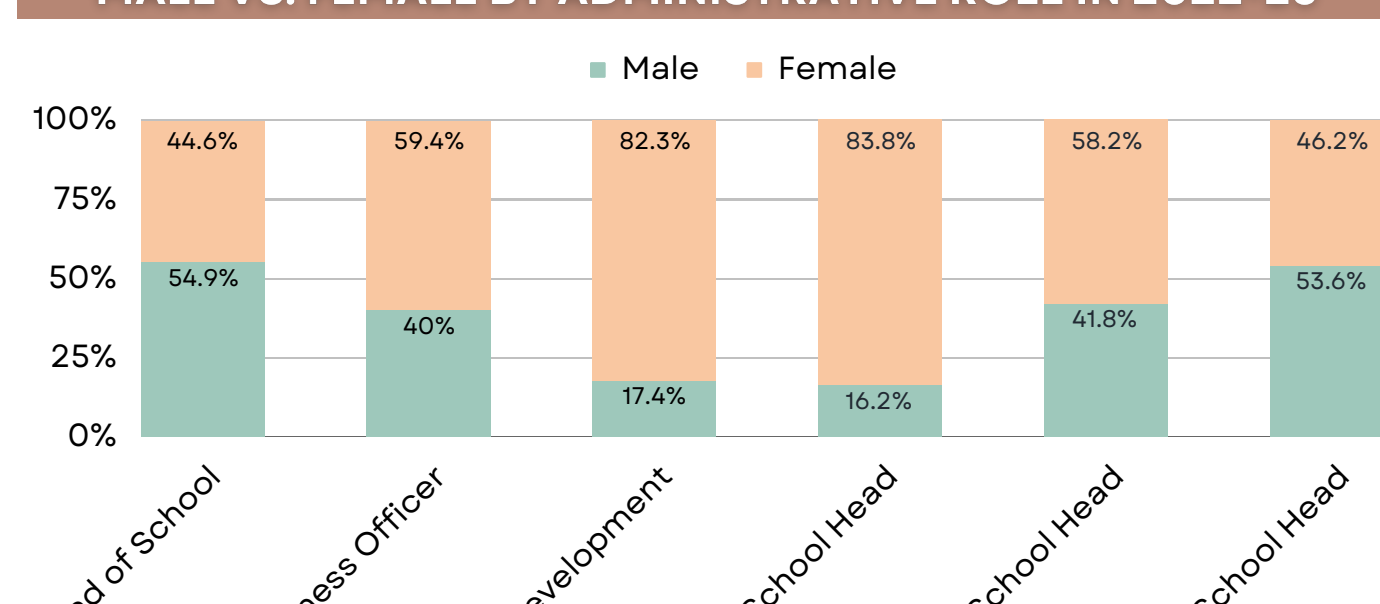

### MALE VS. FEMALE BY ADMINISTRATIVE ROLE IN 2022-23



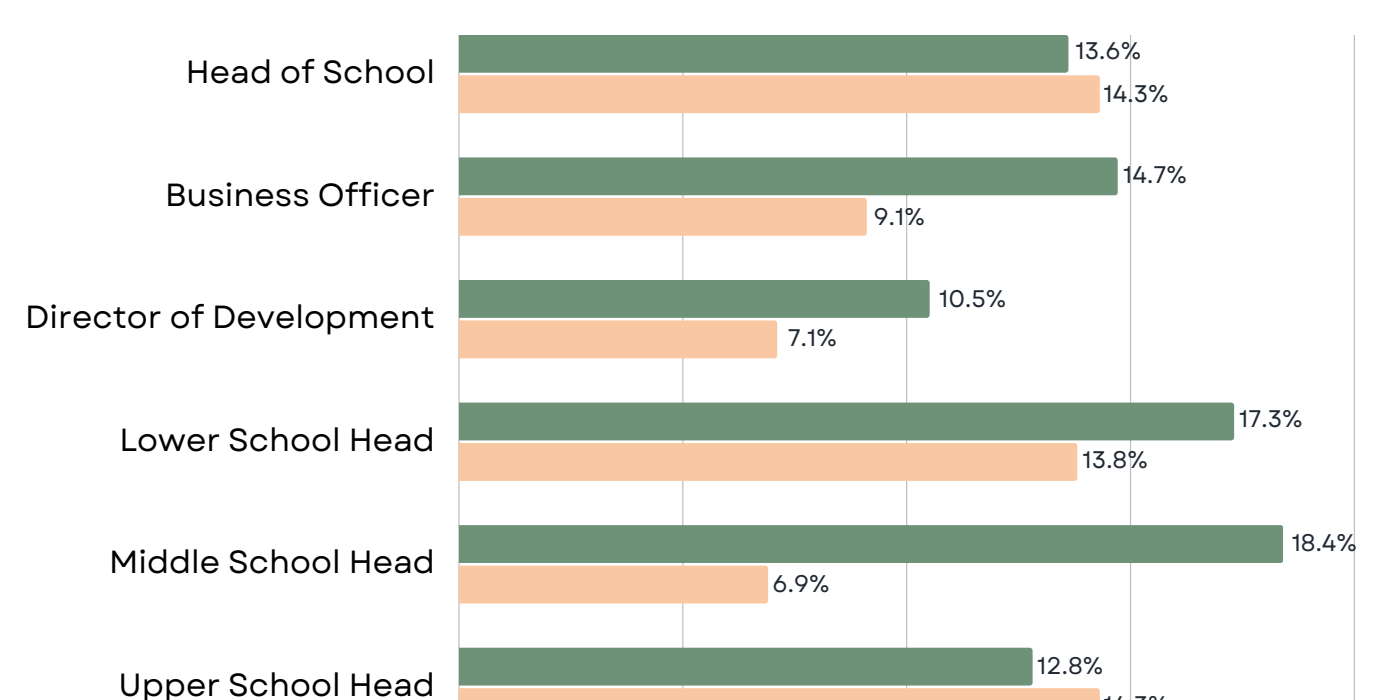

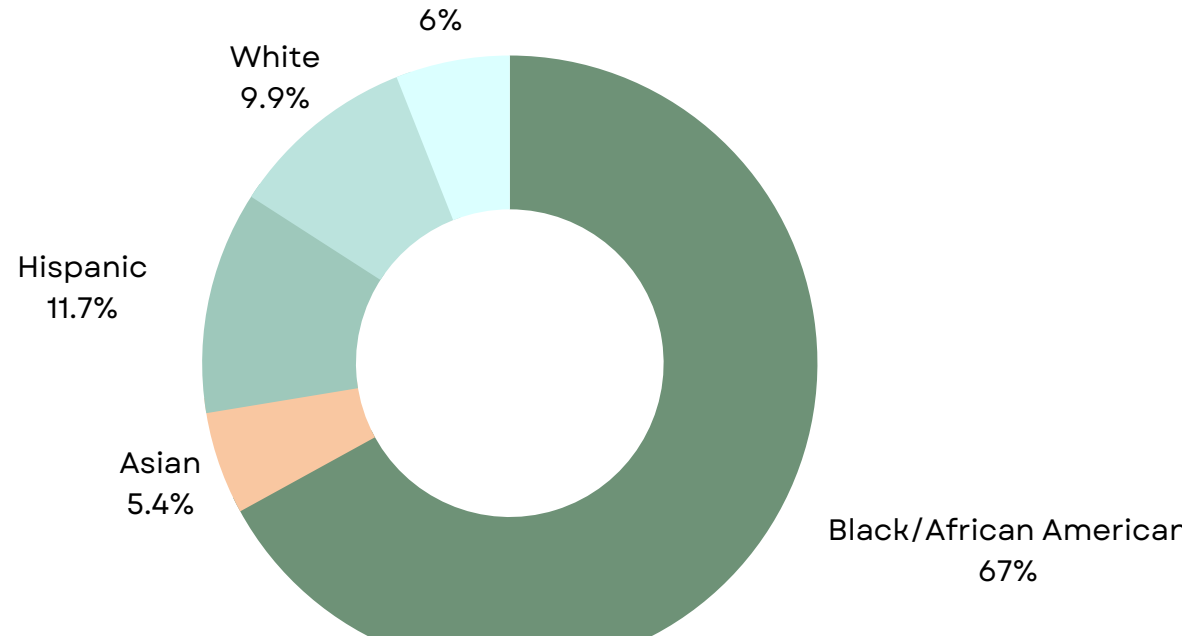
