

ABOUT GHOLDY!



Dr. Gholnecsar (Gholdy) Muhammad began her career as a middle school humanities teacher and later served as a school district curriculum director. She received her PhD in Literacy, Language and Culture at the University of Illinois at Chicago. Her work has appeared in numerous books and journals and she is currently a professor at Georgia State University and the director of the Urban Literacy Collaborative and Clinic. Gholdy works with teachers and young people across the United States and South Africa in best practices in culturally responsive instruction and has been instrumental in shaping the conversation for educating youth who have been underserved. Her many awards include the 2014 National Council of Teachers of English, Promising New Research Award, the 2017 Georgia State University Urban Education Research Award, and the 2018 University of Illinois - Chicago Research of the Year award. Cultivating Genius was released in 2020.
